

Annual Block Fee Options for Dr. Stewart

The Ontario Health Insurance Plan (OHIP) pays for most of your medical visits and services. However, there are some uninsured services, which OHIP does not cover. Please refer to the list of “Uninsured Medical Services” and corresponding fees.

While you may choose to pay for individual services not covered by OHIP on a “Pay-Per-Service” basis, you may also wish to consider paying an “annual fee”, or “block fee”, which is a flat rate that covers most of the uninsured services on an annual basis. *Block fees cover August 1st to July 31st of each year. Fees are not pro-rated if you sign up midway through the year.*

The following is a list of items covered by a single Annual Fee:

- Any forms for physicals, schools, or camps *(normally \$25 each)*
- Any forms for employment or fitness *(normally \$35 each)*
- Sick notes, back to work notes, daycare notes *(normally \$15 each)*
- Insurance Certificates and Attending Physician Statements *(avg \$100 each)*
- Disability Tax Credit applications *(normally \$40 each)*
- Any other general forms *(normally \$40-\$130 each)*
- Photocopies and printing *(\$5 first five pages, \$0.50 per page thereafter)*
- Faxing Documents *(\$5 first five pages, \$0.50 per page thereafter)*
- Physician advice over the telephone *(normally \$20 per 5-minute increment)*

In addition, the Annual Fee gives you the following benefits:

- Waive fees for missed appointment fees (up to 2 per year) *(normally \$30 each)*
- 50% discount off cosmetic procedures *(normally \$30 to \$80 each)*
- 50% discount off Driver’s Physical & form. *(normally \$100 each)*
- 50% discount off Transfers of Medical Records *(normally \$30-\$50 each)*

Cost of an Annual Block Fee:

\$100 per person

\$150 per couple [two adults living at same address]

\$175 per family [parent(s) plus children under 18yo]
